The SeekR is a high quality chase boat for the leisure market as well as Yacht clubs and coaches. Especially designed for NZ and South Pacific conditions, with its high shear bow design it provides a dry ride allowing it to penetrate through all seaways. Orca 828 Hypalon covered D shaped foam fenders made from EVA 45 foam give extra protection and stability. The addition of D shaped tubes has increased the internal volume of the boat while allowing for a seat/shelf for sitting on or stepping from one vessel to another. A full rear bench seat is standard as well as twin tow posts for towing other watercraft. The hull deck and internal structure are entirely CNC moulded.





