The Club 440/490 takes everything that's made the Cormorant the Southern Hemisphere's most popular yacht club chase boat, and builds it heavier and more robust for clubs that need extra durability from their tenders. With reinforced tubes, a heavier-gauge aluminium hull, and slightly more internal beam, this RIB trades a little of the Cormorant's lightness for added strength, stability and space.
